### Columbia River System Operations Comment Period

The review and comment period for the CRSO Draft Environmental Impact Statement opened this morning with the publication of the Notice of Availability in the Federal Register on [www.federalregister.gov](http://www.federalregister.gov).

The U.S. Army Corps of Engineers, Bureau of Reclamation and Bonneville Power Administration invite you to review and provide comments on the draft EIS, which includes the agencies' Preferred Alternative. The attached Availability and Comment Fact Sheet provides details for viewing and downloading the document and options for providing comments, including links to an online comment form and the dates and locations of six public comment meetings.

The comment period ends Monday, April 13, 2020.

The complete draft EIS is a large document. We suggest reading the Executive Summary first, which provides an overview of the major environmental effects of the Preferred Alternative.
